## **Types of restrictions**

Airspace restrictions can have the following form:

- a) danger area;
- b) restricted area;
- c) prohibited area. Zapenjemas

**Prohibited areas** are <u>always</u> closed for flights. They are established over atomic power plants, sensitive/secret chemical complexes and other State installations (установками, сооружениями) which are important for the national security.

Restricted areas are established for military air operations, such as large formation flights, parachute jumping, military exercises, flying displays (парады, демонстрации) and so on. In many cases the activities within these areas are not permanent.

Danger areas are established in areas of potential hazards for flights, for example, rocket firing and other specific (usually) military air activities.

All these areas are published in AIP (Aeronautical Information Publication).
